In 1984 I went to refugee camp (the border of Cambodia and Thailand). At the end of 1986, someone bring me to joint in Christmas time. On that time, I enjoy with them and I want to know about Jesus Christ God. How is Jesus Christ God? (I think) Because I was Buddhism. And then Mrs. Pen Chamnan gave me the booklets to study like the living water book and the gospel according to John etc. Later on I saw the Commandment in Exodus 20:3-5 said that "Thou shall have no other Gods before me. Thou shall not make unto thee any graven image or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. Thou shall not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God -----". So I think that Jesus Christ is not good because he closed the people's freedom. And then I want to stop to study about him continue, but one small spirit command me that you have to study continue to know exactly about Jesus Christ, especially I want to know the true God. Why are there many God in the world? (I think) Which one is true God? How many true Gods in the world? So I study from many booklets more and after that the Spirit of God cause me to know exactly. (There is only one God in the world.) And then I've got changed from my old life to the new life. I stop getting drunk, smoke and play card that I used to have before.
