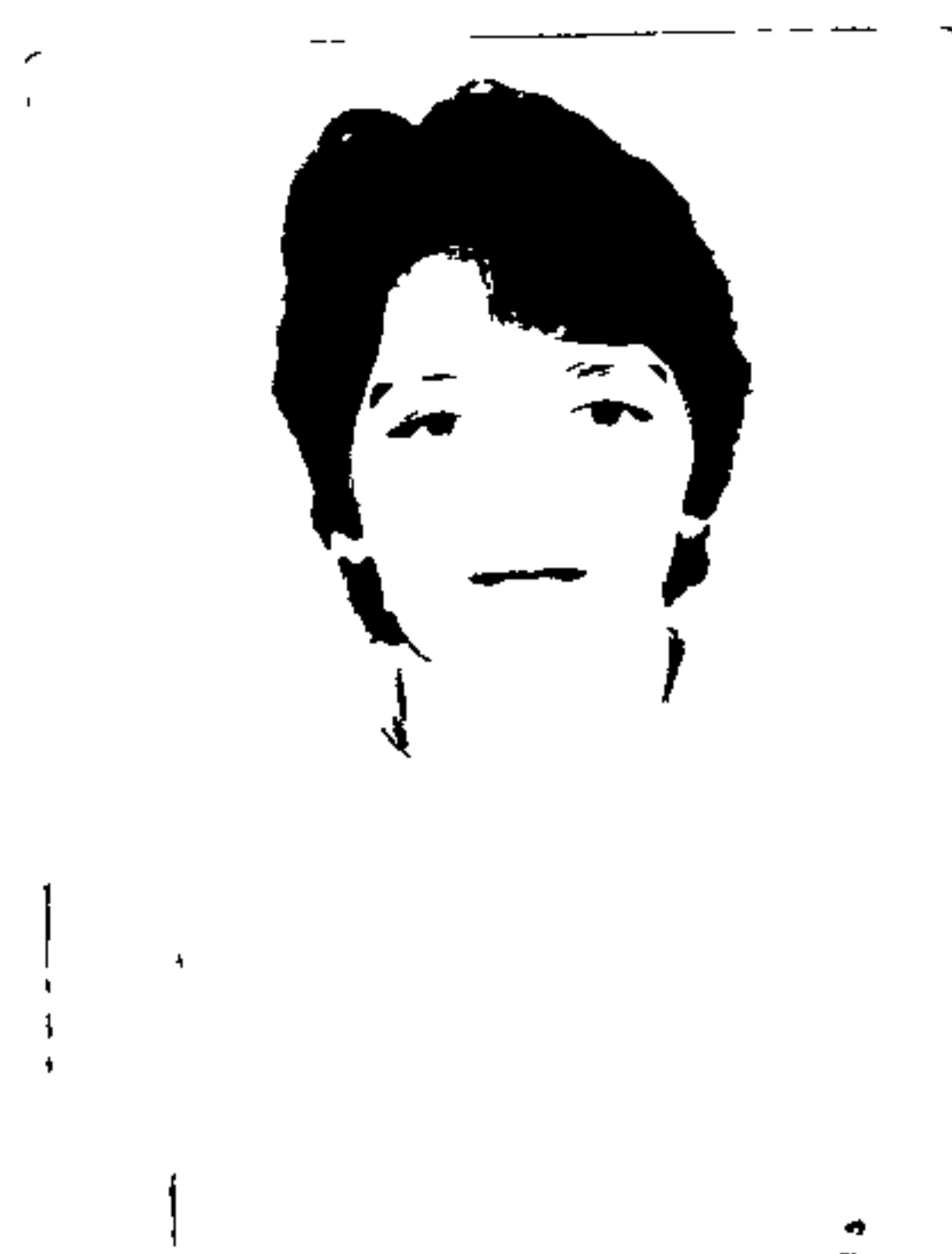

My name is Dan Faina. I was born in a godly Christian family of baptists from village Marca, Romania. Very early in my life I was in touch with Christian love, prayers, God's word. My parents were very concerned to grow me and my brothers in a godly way. So that, as a teenager I was involved in many activities in my church and very confident of my need of salvation. I realised hearing many times God's word that I can't be saved by works, that I needed a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, that it is not enough I have a Christian education and even a participation in ministry. My battle got over when I was 17 years old, receiving Jesus Christ as my saviour and Lord, then I was born again and joy and assurance of salvation flowed in my heart. I was baptized in 1981. Even in that year I understood God's calling to serve Him. I realised the great need to make disciples for Christ. I felt that my training is too low to do the best for Christ, so I applied to the Prophets School of Emanuel Baptist Church Oradea for two years. Meantime I served helping the pastors from villages as Sunday School teacher, evangelizing and in planting churches. Following all experiences I had in ministry, I got to full commitment to ministry as pastor in 1998. I got married twelve years ago, on 24 June 1989 with Livia and God blessed

our family with two daughters: Salome (11 years), Lois (9 years). We are living now in Oradea, but I work as pastor in 9 villages far away of Oradea, about 60-80 km. I am working in a team with pastor Mihaly Balint. God blessed greatly our ministry. In spite of the difficulties to get to those villages we see God working among people and churches growing.
