23 - Describe your wife's typical daily schedule.

My wife wakes up morning for prayers daily, prepares breakfast, goes to the shamba work up to 10 am, she comes back from the shamba for the preparation of lunch. She goes for women teaching and counselling from 2 pm up to 5 pm.

24 - Do you grow your own food or do you purchase it?

I grow my own food like maize, cassavas and purchase some that I do not grow.
