DOCTRINAL STATEMENT.

- (1) Bible - I believe the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, to be verbally inspired Word of God, without error in original writings, and they are the Only Supreme and final authority in faith and life - 2 Peter 1:21; 2 Timothy 3:16-17.
- (2) I believe in one God, eternally existing in three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit - Genesis 1:1; John 10:30; Mathew 28:19; Romans 8:9-11.
- (3) Sin - I believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only Physical death, but also spiritual death, which is separation from God, and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and are therefore under just condemnation to eternal ruin without defense or excuse - Genesis 2:17; Psalms 51:5; 58:3; Romans 1:20; 5:12-21.
